- ENTRY: Regatta will be limited to 30 boats per class.
  Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached entry form and submitting it 14 days prior to the regatta with an entry fee of \$20 for one day or \$35 for both Saturday and Sunday.
  Breakfast, Lunch and drinks provided both days.
  Awards for first 3 competitors.
- SCORING:The regatta will be scored with the Low Point Scoring system as set<br/>forth in Appendix A of the RRS. If there are more than 20 competitors<br/>Races will be run under the Odd/Even Race management system.<br/>One race to be dropped for every 6 sailed.

NOTES: Races will be run on a Saturday for DF65 and Sunday for DF95. Prizes for first three. Can be trophies or bottles of wine. Go Dutch if we have a Saturday night dinner

The only exceptions are the region 7 championships which are solely for one class and run subject to the rules of the organizing club. The championship races will count towards the series of 6 regattas with 4 to count. All clubs to contribute (with the exception of the clubs running the regional championships) to a perpetual traveler's trophy and prizes for first five competitors.
